Level Completion

- Note that Level Completion in Base Camp is only the first step. The VPE must also submit the award in Club Central.
- ▶ A member of more than one club should be clear which club VPE should submit the award as that determines which club gets DCP credit for the award.
- ▶ The VPE who approves the Level Completion in Base Camp does not have to be the same VPE who submits the Level Award in Club Central.
