E-Portfolio Notes

- ▶ The Maximum File Size is 20 MB per file.
- ▶ Folder structure cannot be changed.
- ▶ Uploading files to the E-Portfolio is optional.
- ▶ It is not only for evaluations. Members can upload Word, Excel, audio, video, images, PDFs.
- ▶ Only a member can upload to their own E-Portfolio. If an evaluator fills out the evaluation form electronically they must email it to the speaker. The speaker at their option may upload it to their E-Portfolio.
